Leo McKinstry in his column today laments the effects of mass immigration writing "Apart from the economics, mass immigration has been a disaster for Britain in a host of other ways, from corruption at the ballot box to the growing incidence of bogus marriages, from gangland crime to the importation of superstitions such as African witchcraft and Islamic honour killings," (*'This rising tide of mass immigration must be stopped'*, Daily Express 26th March 2012).
